

Standard Tandem Skydive (which you may have just completed)



Second Tandem Skydive for conversion to Level 2 of the Accelerated Free Fall Course COST - £235



Accelerated Free Fall (AFF) Ground School COST - £120



AFF LEVEL 2 JUMP COST - £250 AIMS: Stability. Altitude awareness. Able to deploy own parachute.



AFF LEVEL 3 JUMP COST - £250 AIMS: Able to maintain a freefall heading without instructor assistance.



AFF LEVEL 4 JUMP COST - £170 AIMS: Start and stop turns.



AFF LEVEL 5 JUMP COST - £170

AIMS: 360 degree turns in either direction.



AFF LEVEL 6 JUMP COST - £170

AIMS: Back loops and Horizontal movement across the sky known as "Tracking".



AFF LEVEL 7 JUMP COST - £170

AIMS: Dive exit. 360 degree turns. Back loop.

Tracking and Track turns.



AFF LEVEL 8 JUMP COST - £75

AIMS: Solo exit and deploy within 10 secs.



10 x CONSOLIDATION JUMPS COST - £50 EACH AIMS: Practice jumps on your own. Can be started after AFF level 7.

50 jumps + Canopy Handling (CH) Grade 2

BPA "C" Licence

Route to **Qualification**

NORTH LONDON SKYDIVING

A more personal service which includes one hour ground school.

Must occur within six months of Standard Tandem Skydive.

Jumps and training take place mid-week.

Allow one full day (mid-week).

Must be completed within 3 months of conversion Tandem Skydive.

Full British Skydiving (BS) Membership

also required COST £115 - at time of printing.

You will need to acquire the skills for each level before being allowed to progress to the next.

To keep the continuity going we recommend completing level 2 to 7 jumps as quickly as possible either by attending regularly (i.e. days apart rather than months apart) or by staying with us on-site until they've been completed – which should save you time and money in the long run. Remember, camping and bunk room accommodation is available on-site free of charge if needed. You should aim to complete one or two jumps per day, weather permitting.

Revision Training Costs are:-

FREE – within one month of last recorded training session.

£36 if one to three months has lapsed since last recorded training session.

£120 if more than three months has lapsed since last recorded training session.

Re-Jumps (If applicable):- Charged at standard rates.

Congratulations you are now a fully qualified skydiver with a licence that is recognised throughout the world.

You can continue jumping with us on a regular basis (without the need to book) for just £25 per jump – excluding equipment hire (which is available for £12 per jump as long as you need it).

Your next goal is to obtain your B, C and D Licences.

This involves moving onto more advanced disciplines, jumping with others, learning how to pack parachutes and perhaps even looking at purchasing your own equipment – which we can advise you on as and when the time comes. A new "Rig" for example costs around £5000.

A good second hand Rig around £3500.
